DIVERS Big Day Out! Including full gear \$299 Own Gear \$259

Our premier trip – ideal for those who only have one day set aside to go diving; Two Wrecks – one AWESOME day!

This trip includes an opportunity to cruise, by boat, up the coast to the Cavalli's before diving the iconic Rainbow Warrior, followed by a trip through the Hole in the Rock and then a BBQ lunch before diving the HMNZS Canterbury.

The Rainbow Warrior, once down the line on the stern you can swim along the boat to the bow. Jewel anemones cover the hull and are the best anywhere. Usually snapper, blue mao mao and baitfish are above the wreck and leatherjackets, pigfish, wrasses and Demoiselles over the deck. Inside are schools of big eyed fish and one or two scorpion fish too.

HMNZS Canterbury wreck is already covered in marine life with resident fish schools including snapper, blue mao mao, leatherjackets, red moki, numerous wrasses and drummer. Big baitfish schools in summer, some nice kingfish and interesting nudibranchs.

Big Three Dive Day! Including full gear \$285 Own Gear \$245

We call this the Big Three Dive Day, because, arguably these are the best three dives in the Cavalli Islands.

We have taken, in our opinion, the most spectacular dive sites and put them into one day for those who want only the best diving experiences in Northland. Ruahine Shoal and Taheke Reef are two awesome dive sites where you can see marlin, sharks, tuna, sunfish and even manta rays may appear. Real blue water dives, not for the faint hearted or inexperienced. The Tunnels offers one of the best dives under 16 metres, with great swim throughs and impressive schools of fish and will complete your Big Three Dive Day experience.



Two Day Dive Special Including full gear \$390 Own Gear \$350

Two days of great diving in both the Cavalli Islands and the Bay of Islands, two wrecks (Rainbow Warrior and HMNZS Canterbury) and two reefs in two days. For those who have more time, this is an opportunity to enjoy probably the best diving in Northland.



One day spent in the Cavalli Islands to dive the internationally known Rainbow Warrior which is always worth a look as she changes every year, followed by a spectacular reef dive. The next day is spent in the Bay of Islands to take in the sheer enormity of the HMNZS Canterbury, followed by one of the amazing reef dives in the Bay.

Cavalli Islands Dive Day Including full gear \$220 Own Gear \$180

The many islands of the Cavalli group always have somewhere that is sheltered from wind and swell. The Rainbow Warrior will always be a great dive but also a dive at True Love Reef or Nukutaunga Island, Kaitireke Reef, The Tunnels or one of the many other spectacular reefs in the Cavalli's.

Bay of Islands Dive Day Including full gear \$220 Own Gear \$180

The Bay of Islands has the attraction of the Canterbury wreck and another dive at one of the many dive sites to choose from Cape Wikiwiki at the northern entrance to The Dog, Pig Gully, Piercy Island, Cathedral Cove and Deep Water Cove.

Deep Adventure Dives Including full gear \$320

We offer Deep Adventure Dives for those who are currently only Open Water certified but want to dive below 18 meters. Naturally, as a responsible professional dive operation, PADI standards will apply to these situations.

Accommodation and diving packages also available

For those not staying on site we will collect you from your accommodation within the Kerikeri to Paihia areas between 7.00 – 7.30am and aim to have you back to your collection point between 3.00 - 3.30pm.

Includes freshly made chicken or ham or free range egg salad rolls with potato chips, homemade Lemon Cake, some fruit and a drink.

Sole Charter Boat Hire \$1,200 per day

Our sole chart hire includes exclusive hire of one of our boats with a qualified skipper and Instructor (or Divemaster as required), 2 sets of full scuba gear and 4 tanks (extra scuba gear is available at \$120 each)
